

# Camp Overnight Packing List

**Packing List** – When preparing for camp, please pack the camper’s possessions in a duffel bag, small footlocker or plastic tub with a secure lid. All clothing and equipment should be marked with the camper’s name and remember to pack extra clothing in case of rainy weather or creek stomping.

## **Equipment –**

- 2 Sheets and 2 Blankets OR Sleeping Bag with a Sheet
- Pillow
- Raincoat or Poncho
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Hat with Brim
- Laundry Bag
- Insect Repellent – No Aerosol Sprays and Sunscreen (non-breakable container)
- Water Bottle with Name
- Backpack or Daypack

## **Personal Items –**

- Soap, shampoo, hair brush, other hair accessories, deodorant, feminine items, toothbrush, toothpaste, shower shoes (highly recommended), eye care needs (such as eyeglasses, contacts with case/solution, etc.), other toiletries as needed.

## **It’s Nice to Have –**

- Camera (inexpensive) and Film
- Stationary, Addresses, Pens/Pencils, Stamps
- Stamped Postcards
- Sunglasses
- Bandana
- Books/Reading Materials for quiet time
- Watch
- Extra Batteries
- Stuffed Animal
- Pre-written mail from parents

## **Don’t Forget –**

All Medication in its original container with written and signed instructions, should stay in the possession of an adult at all times.

## **Clothing –**

- Shorts or pants for each day, plus extras (no short shorts please)
- Shirts for each day, plus extras (no spaghetti straps)
- Long pants or jeans for hiking/horseback riding
- Underwear for each day, plus extras
- Socks for each day, plus extras
- Pajamas
- Sweater, Sweatshirt or Jacket
- Bathing Suit and Towel if planning to swim
- Towels & Washcloths
- 2 Pair Sturdy Shoes, they WILL get wet and dirty! Please make sure they are not too small.
- Boots – Rain boots/extra shoes designated for being wet

\*Girls should plan to bring easy-to-clean wash and wear articles. It is NOT advisable to bring new clothes to camp. Campers wear socks with sturdy shoes due to the poison ivy, tree roots, and other natural hazards in camp. Jelly shoes, “Crocs”, and Clogs are not permitted. Sandals/Flip Flops may only be worn in the shower.

## **PLEASE LEAVE AT HOME:**

Computers, electronic games, radios, CD Players, iPods/MP3 players, Snacks, Candy/Gum, Pop or Food of any kind, Electrical Devices (hair dryers, curling irons, etc.), Sandals, halter tops, Mini-tops, sunsuits, Any Clothing or Equipment advertising adult products, make-up, Cell phones, Expensive Cameras, Items of monetary or sentimental value, Pocket Knife, Girl Scout Uniform. or impairing the safety of others.
