Women in Science program offered for girls in Iowa City

IOWA CITY, Iowa – Girls in grades 6-12 are invited to attend the Women in Science career exploration event at University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics on Saturday, March 28.

Girls can see what real DNA looks like and learn from well-known women doctors, nurses and researchers during the event sponsored by Girl Scouts of Eastern Iowa & Western Illinois. Attendees also can see and feel a real brain or lung.

There also will be a tour of UIHC during the girls' day of science and discovery. Sessions may include, but are not limited to: nursing, anesthesia, heart care, physical therapy, radiology, dentistry and more.
