Honorees are young women who have shown outstanding academic achievement, excellence in leadership, and a commitment to our community through service activities. **Nominees are not required to be a Girl Scout.**

Who is eligible: Any woman ages 17-23 living in the Quad City area who will be attending a high school, college or university during Academic Year 2011-2012. In addition to academic and personal achievements the nominee must display outstanding commitment to the community and live within a thirty mile radius of the Quad Cities.
